FRIDAY / 9 P.M. Book ahead at Alter, the eclectic eatery by Miami "it" chef Bradlev Kilgore, located in the fabulous and funky Wynwood Arts District; 305/ 573-5996 or alter miami.com. Following the five-course tasting menu, browse graffiti murals at Wvnwood Walls: the wynwoodwalls.com.

SATURDAY / 9 A.M. Recharge your batteries with a "Tree of Life Vibrations" healing treatment at Faena's eye-catching Tierra Santa Spa. Afterward, alternate between the hotel's palm-laced swimming pool and the beach Feast on tropical libations and lunch right by the water.

SATURDAY / 3 P.M. UberX to the burgeoning Design District, the apex of Miami's high-design movement and global

retail clout; 305/722-7100 or miamidesign district.net. Gawk at the eye-catching buildings and the impressive tenants housed within, such as the world's largest Jonathan Adler store. a triple-story flagship Hermès, and a Rolex Boutique with a watchmaker on site.

SATURDAY / 6 P.M. Take in the sunsetand the city skylinefrom 40 stories up at Sugar, the ultra-stylish alfresco rooftop lounge at hotel EAST,

SUNDAY / 11 A.M. Explore the picturesque 1930s to 1950s Art Deco glamour of South Beach along Collins Avenue and Ocean Drive from 20th to 5th streets. End vour safari of pastels, portholes, and neons at Prime Fish for a brunch of stone crab claws and filet mignon (plus "bottomless" Bellinis); 305/532-4550 or myles restaurantgroup.com.
